



Utility Billing Rate Update - Per Resolution No. 11-25-24A, rates and fees will be increased annually on January 1st (beginning January 1, 2026). January 2026 utility bills will show the increased amount for water and sewer based on the amount increased by our service wholesaler (OCWUT). 
